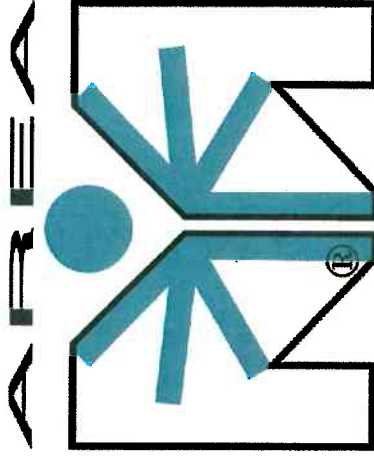

Where: Central Dauphin East High School

Time: 8:30 a.m. — 4:00 p.m.

Participant Fee: \$20 pre-registration
\$25 registration at door

Divisions: Celebrity; Special Olympic Athletes; male and female—High School, ages 20—29; age 30+; (Area M reserves the right to restructure divisions based upon registration)

Format: Double Elimination; games will be h-o-r-s-e. Super Game will be h-o-r-s-e

Benefit: Special Olympic Pennsylvania Area M programs

Each participant will be given a T-shirt for registering. Winners of the divisions will win a medallion and basketball and then earn the right to compete in a Super Game to win the grand prize and the right to be called the "Best Horse Player in Central

- Double elimination competition
- Game of "h-o-r-s-e" semi-finals and finals
- Game of "h-o-r-s-e" for Super Game
- Winner determined by not accumulating letters spelling horse, or surviving sudden-death if tied at end of timed match
- Matches will be timed; 20 minutes per match
- Sudden death overtime if tied at the end of timed match
- Sudden death will be foul shots
- Winner of divisions will win medallion and a basketball, and advance to Super Game to determine competition Winner
- **Grand Prize: two tickets to Philadelphia 76'er game (approximate value \$250)**
- Winner of Super Game will claim the title of "Best Horse Player in Central Pennsylvania" and receive plaque
- All participants will be given a T-shirt to commemorate the competition
- No dunking allowed
- Each match and court will have a referee

Fifth Annual "Horse" Competition Got Game?



On Saturday, April 12 2008, Area M Special Olympics will hold its annual "HORSE" competition. This special fundraiser will raise funds to support Area M's programs to provide training and competition for our special athletes.
